NATIONAL PERFORMANCE COMPETITION

- Entry Fee: Financial members of the New Zealand Riding Pony Society - Free
Non NZRP members - \$30
- The National Performance Competition runs from 1st May 2025 – 30th April 2026
- The competition is open to all ponies 148cm and under, that are fully registered with the NZRP Society
- Rider's age as per RAS rules and regulations
- Completed score sheets are to be with the Performance Co-ordinator by 30th April 2025
- Events eligible for inclusion in the Open Pony, Junior Pony, First Ridden Pony & Lead Rein competition are: Open and novice conformation, NZRP sash classes, and open and novice paced & mannered classes.
- Events eligible for inclusion in the Versatility Trophy Competition are: Conformation classes on the flat, paced and mannered classes, dressage, mounted games, round the ring jumping, working hunter, show jumping, show hunter, eventing & Pony Club events (training days not applicable)
- No turnout/best presented, district/local, or led classes are accepted (these include dry mare, gelding, and handler classes).
- Awards will be presented at the Society's 2026 AGM, and winners will be notified prior.

COMPETITION DETAILS & AWARDS

OPEN PONY (8 years and over)

Winner receives the **Perpetual NZRP Shield and a NZRP monogrammed dress rug**. *Results from the best 10 competitions are counted for scoring.* Entrants to complete the NZRP score sheet

JUNIOR PONY (ponies 4 - 7 years)

Winner receives the **Perpetual Jenkins Trophy and a NZRP monogrammed dress rug**. *Results from the best 6 competitions are counted for scoring.* Entrants to complete the NZRP score sheet.

FIRST RIDDEN PONY (ponies 4 years and over)

Winner receives a **NZRP saddle blanket**. *Results from the best 10 competitions are counted for scoring.* Entrants to complete the NZRP First Ridden score sheet.

LEAD REIN PONY (ponies 4 years and over)

Winner receives a **NZRP saddle blanket**. *Results from the best 10 competitions are counted for scoring* Entrants to complete the NZRP Lead Rein score sheet.

VERSATILITY TROPHY (ponies 5 years & over)

Winner receives the Perpetual Woodlands Park Versatility Trophy, and a NZRP saddle blanket. *Top results from a variety of disciplines to be considered.* Entrants to complete the Woodlands Park Trophy form

JUNIOR RIDER TROPHY

Winner receives the Perpetual Glen Cree Junior Rider Trophy. To be presented to the rider that gains the most points on a pony/ponies entered in the Junior Performance Competition.

ROSETTES, awarded to:

- * Place getters in the Senior Competition, the Junior Competition, and the Lead Rein and First Ridden competition (1st – 6th)
- * Woodlands Park Versatility Trophy/Competition (1st – 6th)
- * Breeder of Senior Competition winner
